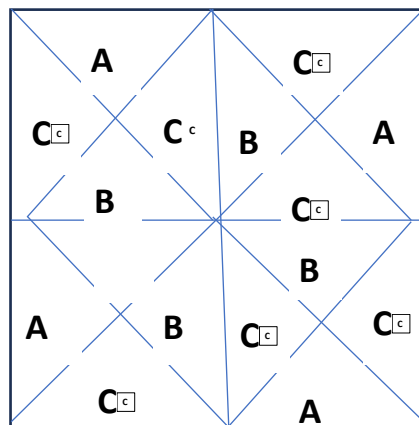


CVQG Block of the Month – September 2025



Fabric Requirements:

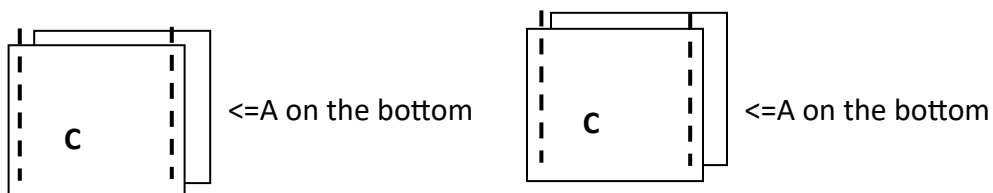
Two - 5" squares of Fabric A – used as the accent fabric

Two - 5" squares of Fabric B – used as the outer triangles

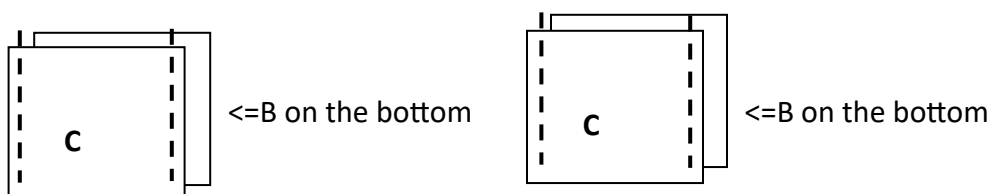
Four – 5" square of Fabric C – used as the background fabric

Notes: All seams are $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Stitching lines are indicated as dotted lines. _ _ _ _ _

1. Place fabric C to fabric A right sides together (RST) with fabric C on top facing down. Stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam from the edge towards the center on two opposite sides. Repeat for 1 more set of fabric C and fabric A.

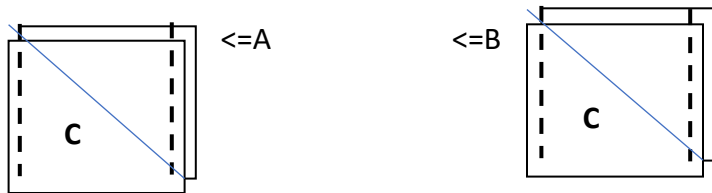


2. Place RST fabric B to fabric C. Stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam in on two opposite sides. Repeat for 1 more set of fabric B and fabric C.



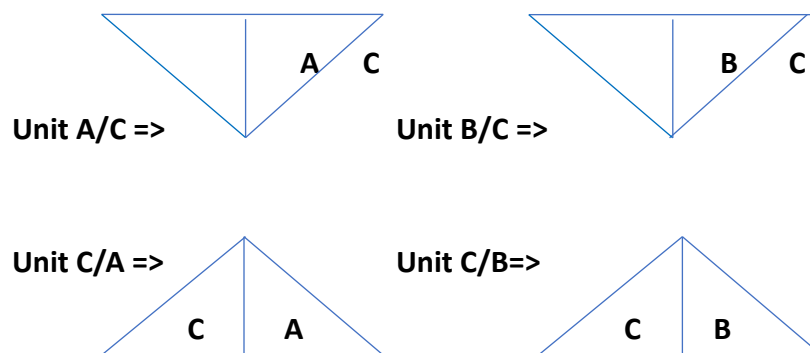
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- With the back side of fabric C facing up, Cut the sewn squares across the diagonal as shown below. Cut on the diagonal from top left to bottom right for each of the four units.

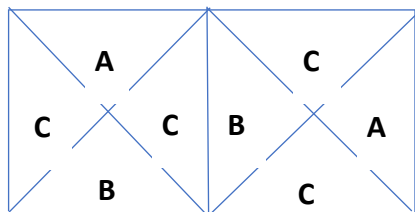


- When you open the triangles, a few stitches will come apart (or you need to take them out) at the bottom right corner. *Note: My two or three stitches fell apart when I opened the cut triangles.*

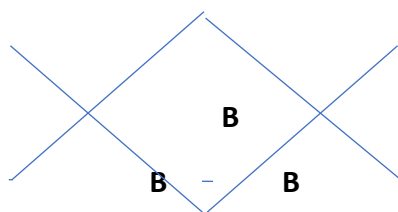
- Press the seams away from A and away from B to create triangles.



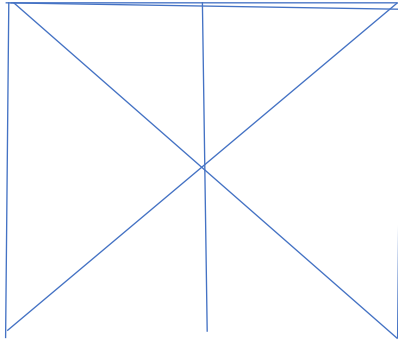
- Place units C/A, B/C, A/C, AND C/B as shown below. Replicate this to the second set of four units.



- Place sewn units together, as shown in the graphic layout at the top of the instructions, next to the sample made in fabric.



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8. Block should finish at approximately 12 ½" square.
