

Hearts Block

Block of the Month February, 2025

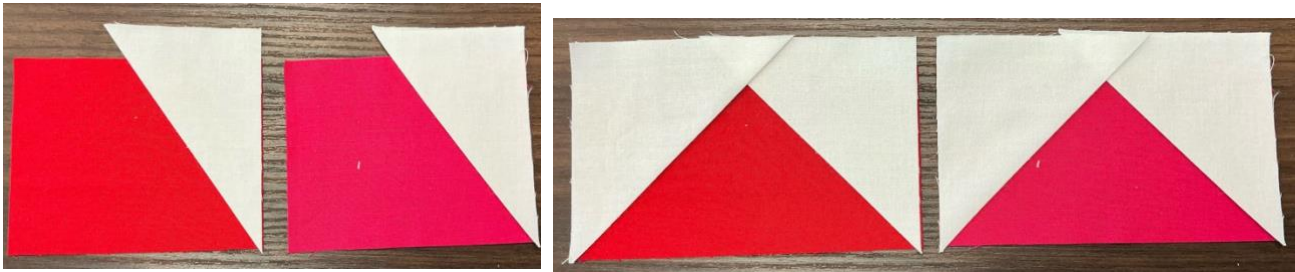
10" finished (10 1/2" unfinished)

Cutting:

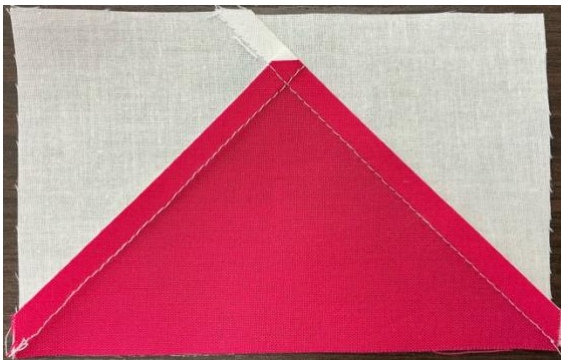
White/white on white: 4 squares 3 1/2", 2 rectangles 5 1/2" x 7"

Various reds/pinks: 2 rectangles 5 1/2" x 7", 2 rectangles 3" x 5 1/2", 2 rectangles 1" x 5 1/2"

Using the red/pink 3" x 5 1/2" rectangles and white 3 1/2" squares make 2 flying geese. Fold the 3 1/2 squares in half diagonally. Open up each square and sew diagonally.



Trim the excess layers.



Sew a red/pink 1" x 5 1/2" rectangle to the bottom of each flying geese.



Using the red/pink $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7" rectangles and $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7" white rectangles sew them diagonally to form a rectangle that is half white and half red/pink. Make sure to sew the diagonal seams in opposite directions. Trim off the underneath layers.



Sew each $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7" rectangle to the 1" x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle then sew the two halves together complete the block.
