

# CVQG Block of the Month – May 2026

This block is great to highlight a favorite fabric design by fussy cutting the center! Use a scant  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam.

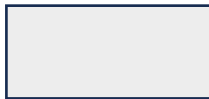
## Fabric Requirements:

Fabric A –  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " by  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " print. This is the center of the block.



$6\frac{1}{2}$ " by  $6\frac{1}{2}$ "

Fabric B – four (4)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. This fabric should be white or white-on-white.



$2\frac{1}{2}$ " by  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 strips

Fabric C – four (4)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " print fabrics. Each  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " piece should be a different print, coordinated with the center print.



$2\frac{1}{2}$ " by  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 squares

## Block Construction Steps:

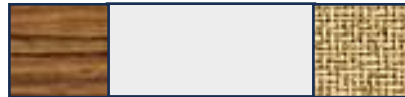
**Step 1.** Sew one  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " X  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " white strip (Fabric B) to left of the  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " X  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " center block (Fabric A) and one  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " X  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " white strip to the right side of the center block. Press seams towards the center block.

**Step 2.** Sew one 2 ½" X 2 ½" print square (Fabric C) to left of the 2 ½" X 6 ½" white rectangle (Fabric B) and one 2 ½" X 2 ½" print square (Fabric C) to the right side of 2 ½" X 6 ½" white rectangle (Fabric B). Repeat for both remaining white strips.

**Step 3.** Sew the two strips made in step 2 to the top and bottom of the center row strip made in step 1.

**Step 4.** Square up the block to 10 ½" square. This is the unfinished size.
