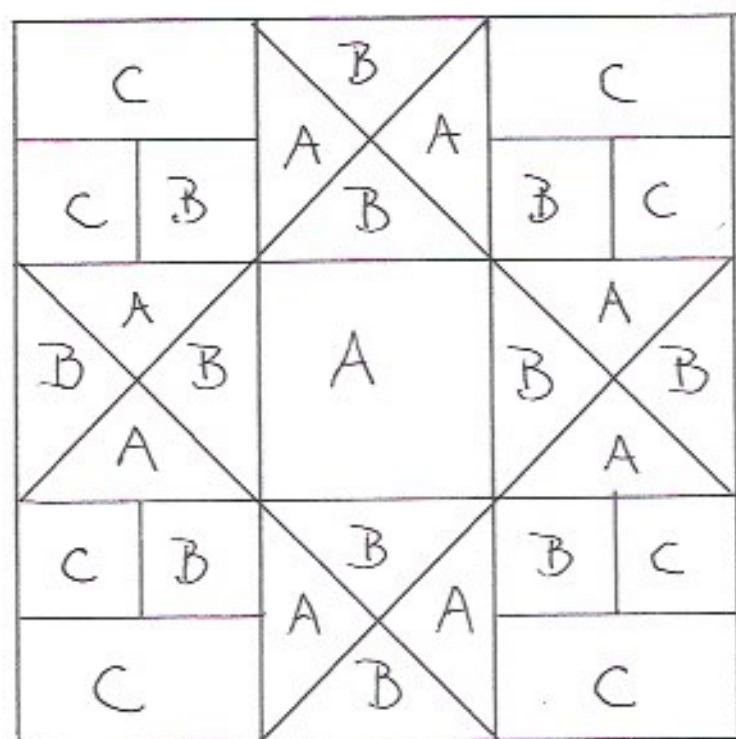




Fabric Requirements

Color A: Cut 1 @ $3\frac{1}{2}$ " sq.
and 2 @ $4\frac{1}{4}$ " sq.

Color B: Cut 4 @ 2" sq.
and 2 @ $4\frac{1}{4}$ " sq.

Color C: Cut 4 @ 2" sq.
and 4 @ $2 \times 3\frac{1}{2}$ "

Construction:

Make the 4 hourglass units using the $4\frac{1}{4}$ " squares. Mark the diagonal on the lighter fabric, layer with the darker; sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on either side of the line. Cut apart and press to the darker fabric. Nest 2 units together with the light fabric over the dark. Mark a diagonal and sew on either side, $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the line. Cut apart.

Sew the 2" C and B squares together, then add the $3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle.

Make sure the 2" B square is in the "correct" corner.

Lay out the squares as per the diagram. Sew the squares to make the rows, then sew the rows together.

$9\frac{1}{2}$ " block to turn in.
