

CVQG Block of the Month – September 2026

This block is a Scrap Buster! A great use of scraps!

Fabric Requirements:

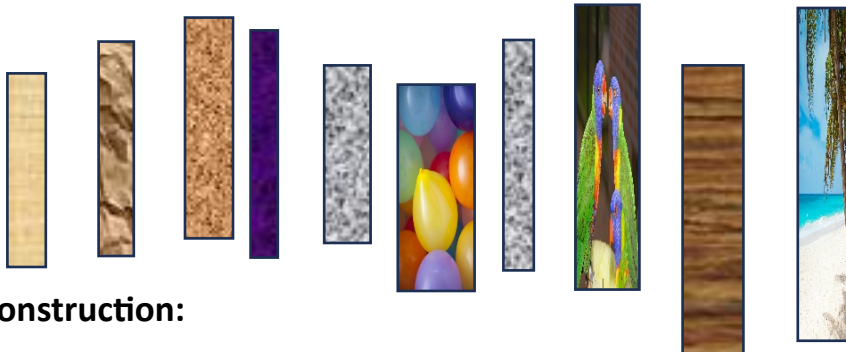
Fabric A — Muslin or muslin substitute to use as foundation fabric – 10” square



Fabric B – Black for the snowball corners – 4 – 2 ½” squares



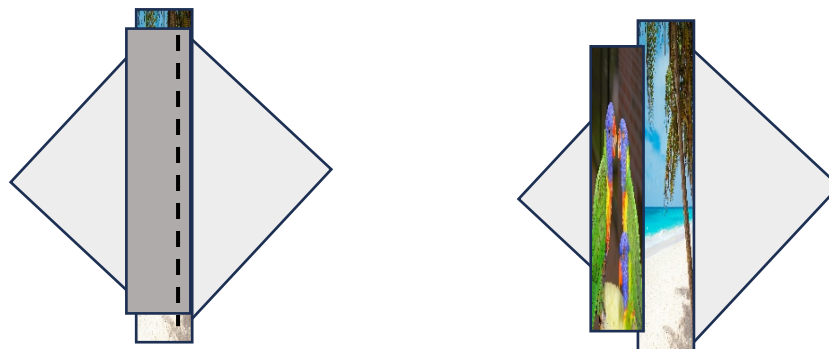
Fabrics C – at least 8 to 10 scrap fabrics between 11” and 4” long and of any width.



Block construction:

Step 1. Pick a point on the diagonal of the muslin foundation fabric. Lay the longest scrap fabric right side up on the muslin. Lay the next fabric on top of the first fabric, with right sides together. Sew through the 3 layers, using a ¼” seam allowance. Press the scrap fabrics open.

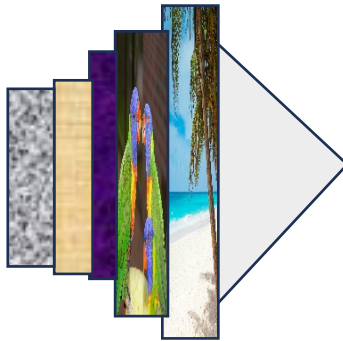
Step 2. Lay a third scrap fabric on the unsewn long edge of the second piece, right sides together. Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam attaching the 2 fabrics together. Press the third scrap fabric open.

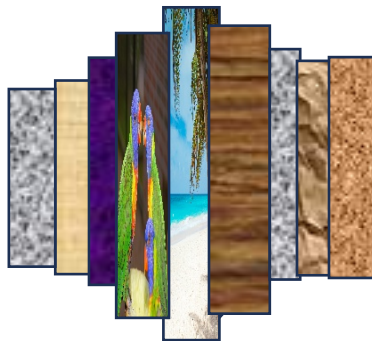
Step 3. Repeat step 2 with a fourth, fifth, etc. scrap fabric until that side of the muslin foundation is covered with scraps.

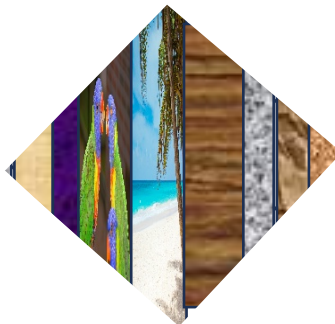
Step 4. Repeat on the other side of the muslin foundation until the entire muslin piece is covered. Make sure the scrap fabrics extend beyond the muslin foundation fabric.

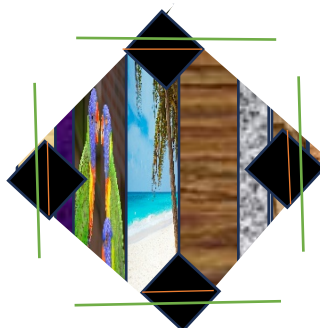
Step 5. Square the block to 9 ½”.

Step 6. Lay a 2 ½” square onto each of the four corners of the scrappy block made in Step 5. Sew them onto the scrappy block along the orange line as shown below. Trim the black square to a ¼” seam on the side toward the inside of the block. See green line below.

Step 7. Press the black corner piece to the outside. Square the block to 9 ½”. Your block should look something like this!
