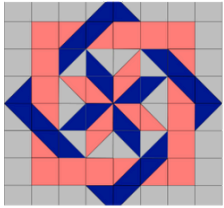




LABYRINTH QUILT BLOCK INSTRUCTIONS



Block Size 14" –
Intended use: Back
panel for quilted coat

Fabric Requirements

(For one 14" block)

Fabric	Requirement
A	1/6 yard or 5" x WOF (plus extra if using for coat background)
B	1/6 yard or 5" x WOF
C	3" x WOF

Cutting Instructions

Fabric A

- Cut one 2.25" x WOF strip → Subcut 17 – 2.25" squares
- Cut one 2.75" x WOF strip → Subcut 10 – 2.75" squares
- Also cut 3 – 2.5" squares

Fabric B

- Cut one 2.25" x WOF strip → Subcut 12 – 2.25" squares
- Cut one 2.75" x WOF strip → Subcut 8 – 2.75" squares

Fabric C

- Cut one 2.75" x WOF strip → Subcut 14 – 2.75" squares

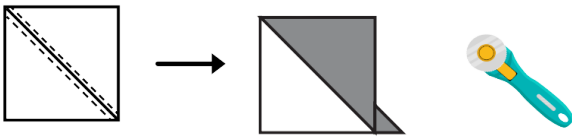
▲ Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

You will need:

- 16 A/C HSTs
- 4 A/B HSTs
- 12 B/C HSTs

Instructions:

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each 2.75" square.
2. Pair right sides together.
3. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the line.
4. Cut on the line and press open.
5. Trim each HST to 2.5".



✚ Assembly Instructions

1. Lay out your block pieces according to the diagram.
2. Assemble in rows.
3. Press each row in alternating directions for nesting seams.

👉 Bonus: Pinwheel Pocket Blocks

1. Begin with **two 7.25" squares**.
2. On one square, draw diagonals from top left and top right corners.
3. Place right sides together and sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " from each line.
4. Cut along drawn lines and then vertically & horizontally through the center.
5. Trim each HST to 3".
6. Sew HSTs into two rows to create **two 5" pinwheel blocks**.
