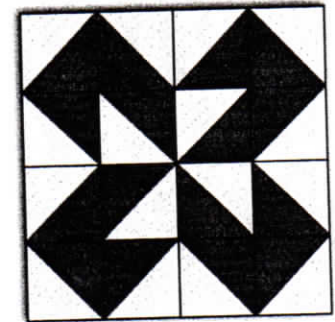


OCTOBER 2017 ~ BLOCK OF THE MONTH

THINK PINK !

THIS IS A 12" BLOCK



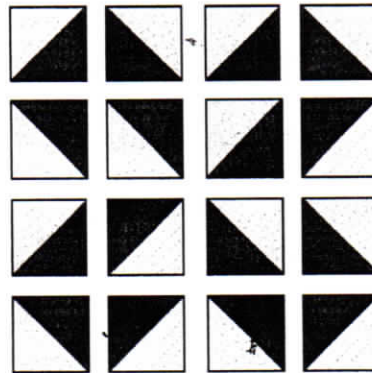
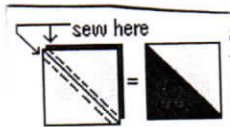
Supplies needed :

1 – 3.7/8" x 31" strip light pink fabric

1 – 3.7/8" x 31" strip medium or dark pink fabric

Stack and align your two strips together. Cut at 3.7/8" intervals to make 8 3.7/8" squares, separate fabric and you have a total of 16 squares.

Take one light pink and one darker pink, sew down the diagonal and cut to make two half square triangles. Trim if need be to measure 3.5" square. You need a total of 16 half square triangles for this block. Lay out as shown below and sew together.



On a personal note: I went pink this month since October is Breast Cancer Awareness month and I work for a plastic surgeon that does reconstruction on women after mastectomy. Dealing with breast cancer survivors for the past twelve years I have learned just how many lives this touches. The winner or winners of these blocks could create a quilt for a survivor or someone going through treatment. Pink is always good for a baby quilt also.
