## CVQG BLOCK OF THE MONTH for JUNE, 2018 - WILD FLOWER

## **FABRIC REQUIREMENTS**

4 @ 5-1/2" squares, Flower

4 @ 1--1/2" squares Flower Center

8 @ 2-1/2" squares green background

4 @ 1-1/2" squares green background

2 @ 2" x 10-1/2" green background

2 @ 2" x 13-1/2" green background

## **ASSEMBLY:**

Mark diagonal lines on the wrong side of all of the 1-1/2" and 2-1/2" squares. Place a 1-1/2" center color square on the top left corner of each of the 5-1/2" flower squares; sew on the diagonal line, trim and press.

Place a 1-1/2" background square on each of the flower squares on the top right corner; sew on the diagonal, trim and press.

Place a 2-1/2" background square on each of the two remaining corners of each of the flower squares; sew on the diagonal, trim and press. You now have a lopsided "snowball" block.

Sew the 4 flower blocks as per diagram.

Sew the 10-1/2" background strips to the top and bottom of the 4-petal block; press. Sew the 13-1/2" background strips to the sides.
