## Mystery Quill

For this section you will need the following pieces from the fabric you cut:
Fabric A: $65^{\prime \prime}$ squares and $2431 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
Fabric B: 24 2" $\times 5$ " rectangles
Fabric C: 24 2" squares
Fabric E: 48 2" squares
Assemble 24 units like this:


Then add a $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ A square to either end of 12 of the units:


Then using the remaining 12 units, sew a " $B$ " edge to opposite sides of the six 5" A squares.


Then assemble the rows/sections to form 6 squares.
