Block of the Month – April

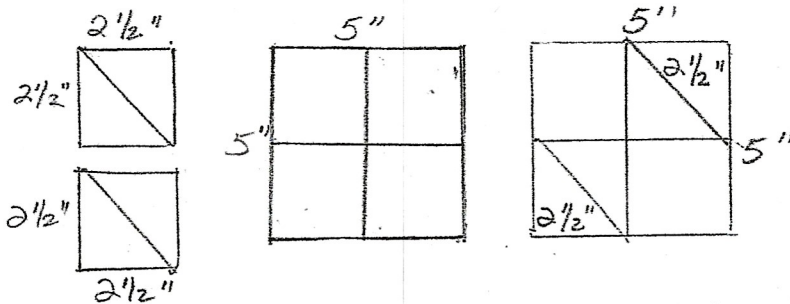
Fabric requirements:

four 5" squares, preferably in bright colors; can be solids or prints

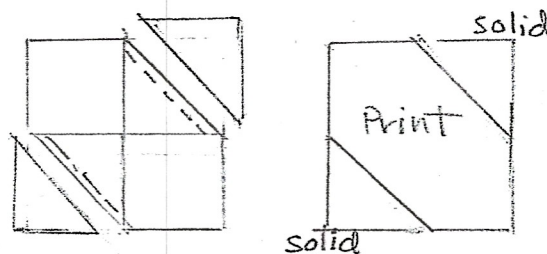
eight 2 1/2" squares, preferably in solid black or black-on-black print

Directions:

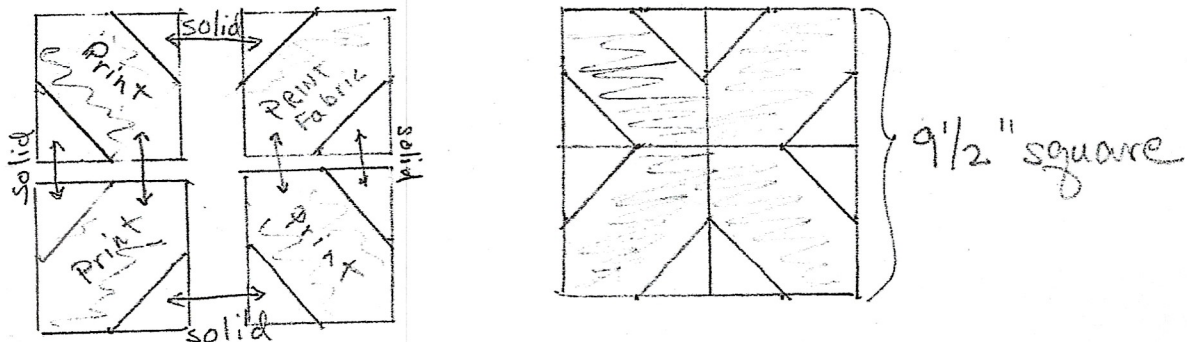
Layer two 2 1/2" black squares on the lower left and the upper right corner of one of the 5" squares, right sides together. Draw diagonal lines across the 2 1/2" black squares from the square's top left to bottom right corner. Repeat on both black squares. Sew along the diagonal line joining the black squares to the 5" square. Sew along the diagonal line joining the black squares to the 5" square.



Trim 1/4" from the seam line. Press to the corners to form triangles. Repeat to make a total of four blocks that are 5" square.



Large block. Take four blocks and lay them solid to solid and print to print. Sew together to form your final block. Square up to 9 1/2" block.



Design from free block on Missouri Star Quilt Co. as modified for Road to California's Roadies Give Back block. Modifications made to that block by starting with a single 5" square, not pieced.
