
February 2016 Block of the Month—No Sew Hearts



SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- 1. Cut 3-Light red or pink fabric 6.5"x 6.5"
- 2. Cut 3-dark red or pink fabric 6.5"x 6.5"
- 3. 2-paper backed fusible web squares 6.5" x6.5"
- 4. Sharp scissors, iron, rotary cutter and ruler

Step 1.

Place the fusible web (shiny/non-web side up) over the heart and frame pattern, and trace the hearts. Make two copies, one for the dark fabric and one for the light fabric. I use lightweight Wonder Under, any brand will do as long as it is lightweight.



Step 2.

Fuse the squares of fusible web to the wrong sides of 1 light and 1 dark fabric square.



Step 3.

Take a fabric square and fold in half. Carefully cut the hearts out. When you are done you will have 3 motifs; the heart, the frame and the background heart.





Remove the paper backing from the back of each motif.

Step 4.

Place the two unfused fabric squares right side up on a pressing surface (1 dark & 1 light). Put the light heart and the light border on the dark fabric square. Place the light background on another dark square. Fuse the motifs to the fabric squares.



Step 5.

Using the dark square with the fusible pattern attached you made in step one, repeat steps 2, 3 & 4 using dark motifs. Place the dark motifs on the light colored plain blocks. When completed you will have 4 completed heart blocks ready for edges to be finished or embellished. You can leave the edges unfinished for the Block of the Month.







I added another variation by using light pink solid and darker pink print. Have fun using up Fabrics from your stash.
