## September 2016 Block of the Month Stars \& Stripes

## SUPPLIES NEEDED FOR 4 BLOCKS:

1. 4 assorted red solid or print fabrics
2. 4 assorted white solid or print fabrics
3. 1 dark blue $\&$ white star or dot print fabric
4. Thread, rotary cutter, cutting mat, ruler and iron
5. To complete a block from the sewn strip sets, you need:
$1-3.5^{\prime \prime} \times 6.5^{\prime \prime}$ red, white, red, strip set
$1-3.5^{\prime \prime} \times 3.5^{\prime \prime}$ square, blue print
$1-5.5^{\prime \prime} \times 9.5^{\prime \prime}$ white, red, white, red, white, strip set

## Step 1.

Cut (4) $1.5^{\prime \prime}$ strips, width of fabric, from the red solids/prints. Cut (4)1.5" strips, width of fabric, from the white solids/prints. Cut (4) $3.5^{\prime \prime} \times 3.5^{\prime \prime}$ squares from the dark blue $\&$ white fabric.


## Step 2.

Sew two strip sets. Set 1 consists of 1 white strip and 2 red strips. Set 2 consists of 3 white strips and 2 red strips. Sew strips together using a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam. Press fabrics to the darker fabric.

## Step 3.

Cut strip set 1 into $6.5^{\prime \prime}$ long sections. These should measure $3.5^{\prime \prime} \times 6.5^{\prime \prime}$. Cut strip set 2 into $9.5^{\prime \prime}$ long sections. These should measure $5.5^{\prime \prime} \times 9.5^{\prime \prime}$.


## Step 4.

With right sides together, sew the $3.5^{\prime \prime} \times 3.5^{\prime \prime}$ square to strip set 1. Press seams to the
 darker fabric.

## Step 5.

With right sides together, sew the strip set from Step 4 to strip set 2 ( $5.5^{\prime \prime} \times 9.5^{\prime \prime}$ ). Press to the darker fabric. Trim as needed.
Your block is complete.


Repeat to make additional blocks.

Finished block should measure $9.5^{\prime \prime}$ wide and $8.5^{\prime \prime}$ high.
