

# October Block —Autumn/Halloween Square

**MATERIALS LIST FOR 1 BLOCK—Finished size is approximately 9.5" x 9.5"**

1. 3-assorted fall or Halloween fabrics—1 light/medium, 1 medium or dark and 1 contrasting novelty or solid for starting square. Charm packs, jelly rolls, or scraps can be used for the block.

2. Thread for piecing

3. For piecing one block cut the following:

- 1—4" x 4" novelty fabric
- 2—1.5" x 4" light/medium fabric
- 2—1.5" x 6" light/medium fabric
- 2—2.5" x 6" medium/dark fabric
- 2—2.5" x 10" medium/dark fabric



**Step 1** —Sew a 1.5"x4" strip to the top of the 4"x 4" square. Press seam to the darker fabric. Trim as needed

**Step 2**—Sew the 2nd 1.5'x 4" strip to the bottom or opposite side of the block. Press seam to the darker fabric. Trim as needed.



**Step 3**—Sew 1.5"x 6" strip to the top of the block. Press to the dark fabric. Trim as needed





**Step 4**—Sew the 2nd 1.5”x6” strip to the opposite side of the block. Press to the dark fabric. Trim as needed



**Step 5**—Sew a 2.5”x 6” strip to two sides of the block. Press to the dark fabric. Trim as needed.



**Step 6**—Add a 2.5”x 10” strip to the one side of the block. Press to the dark fabric. Add the 2nd 2.5”x10” strip to the block. Trim to square up the block. Block is finished.
